OFFICIAL RULES AND MECHANICS FOR THE THREE CATEGORIES OF 2015 PRESIDENTIAL INNOVATION AWARD

SHORT FILM CATEGORY

Eligible Participants: PNU Undergraduate Students

Required Length: 6-8 minutes

Theme: PNU LEGACY and/or FUTURE PNU

Mechanics:

- 1. A team of at least five (5) enrolled students preferably from varied specializations and year levels may join by registering and submitting their entry. There should be one entry per team and an individual may be involved only in one team. Registration forms are available at the University Events and Public Relations Office.
- 2. The entry consists of not more than 8 minutes indie film that talks about any of the two themes namely, PNU's PAST 100 YEARS (legacy) and PNU'S NEXT 100 YEARS (our dream PNU). The video may be in avi, mpegg4, mov or flv file format.
- 3. The video submissions must be in sealed brown envelope containing two video CDs and the registration form. The video CDs shall be numbered 1, and 2. CD number 1 contains the video with the names of the team members in the application form and in the video itself. CD number 2 contains the same video entry which shall have NO NAMES of the members of the team. The latter CD shall be used for judging the video entry.
- 4. The video film must be given a title. The title of the video shall be placed on the envelope, on the registration form, the video CD's and in the video itself.
- 5. The PNU name and logo should appear anywhere in the video.

- 6. Deadline of the submission of entries: August 15, 2015 at 10:00 A.M. in the morning at the Office of University Events and Public Relations Office.
- 7. The preliminary board of judges shall identify a maximum of five quality entries for each theme which will be uploaded at the university website for students' votes. The votes constitute 30% of the score. The 70% of the scores will come from the votes of the Board of external experts.
- 8. Student on-line voting begins at 9:00 a.m. on August 17, 2015, thru the university website via the link: **Presidential Innovation Awards for Short Film**. On-line voting ends at 3:00P.M. of August 27, 2015. Only registered students can vote using their student numbers as their username (lowercase) and their surnames (all caps) as their Password. Each student may vote only once.
- 9. The winners will be announced on Sept. 1, 2015 during the Foundation Week celebrations.

DOCUMENTARY FILM CATEGORY

Eligible Participants: External Group with PNU Alumni

Required length: 10-15 minutes

Theme: TRADITION ON and EFFORTS for EXCELLENCE

Mechanics:

- 1. A team of at least five (5) members which composed of 3 or 4 participants from outside PNU plus 1 or 2 alumni may join by registering and submitting their entry. There should be one entry per team and an individual may be involved only in one team. Registration form are available at the University Events and Public Relations Office.
- 2. The entry consists of not more than 15 minutes documentary film of **PNU's impact and influence on Philippine society**. The video may be in avi, mpegg4, mov or flv file format. There should be one entry per team and an individual may be involved only in one team.
- 3. The video submissions must be in sealed brown envelope containing two video CDs and the registration form. The video CDs shall be numbered 1, and 2. CD number 1 contains the video with the names of the team members in the application form and in the video itself. CD number 2 contains the same video entry which shall have NO NAMES of the members of the team. The latter CD shall be used for judging the video entry.
- 4. The video film must be given a title. The title of the video shall be placed on the envelope, on the registration form, the video CD's and in the video itself.
